



ADA Facility Accessibility Policy

1. Purpose

This policy outlines how Live Oak County ensures physical accessibility of its public facilities for individuals with disabilities, in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and related regulations.

2. Accessibility Features

Live Oak County is committed to providing accessible facilities for all residents and visitors. The County Courthouse and associated public buildings include the following accessibility features:

- ADA-compliant entry ramps at main entrances
- Electric door openers activated by accessible push-button controls
- Designated ADA parking spaces located near accessible entrances
- Accessible restrooms with appropriate signage, grab bars, and clear floor space
- Wide hallways and doorways that meet ADA clearance requirements

3. Maintenance and Monitoring

All accessibility features are inspected regularly by County maintenance staff to ensure continued operation. Automatic door openers and ramps are maintained in proper working condition. Any malfunctioning equipment is repaired promptly upon identification or notification.

4. Requests for Additional Accommodation

Individuals who require additional accommodations to access county facilities or services may contact the ADA Coordinator. Reasonable modifications will be provided upon request, in a timely and effective manner.
