

Poll Watcher Check List

- Check ID of the poll watcher
- Give the poll watcher a name tag
- Check the date on the Certificate of Appointment and the Certificate of Completion of Training they provide is valid
- Verify signed by the appointing authority and filled out accurately
- Administer the Oath and have them fill out the affidavit, both of them are on the bottom of the Certificate of Appointment
- Verify No Cell Phone with them or silent/off
- Compare their signatures
- The judge will sign and date the certificate of appointment
- Note the time when they arrive and when they leave on the top of the sheet
- Place in Yellow Envelope #2:
 - Certificate of Appointment
 - Certificate of Completion of Training

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Come in at any time during the day May serve at the polling place during the hours the watcher chooses. (updated 9/1/2023, 5 consecutive hours no longer required) Observe, not obstruct, all election activities performed by the judge and clerks Make written notes Accompany the election official to deliver supplies or return equipment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enter the polling location with any mechanical or electronic means of recording image or sound. Use a cellphone in the polling location Wear a name badge indicating their party affiliation or position on any candidate or measure on the ballot Communicate with anyone unless to point out an observed irregularity to the Election Judge Watch the voter vote unless they are being assisted by an election worker
