

COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER IN RE:

DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR LIVE OAK COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, on 5/10/2021, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a local state of disaster for Live Oak County, resulting from the imminent threat of disaster from the unprecedented levels of illegal immigration, human trafficking, and drug smuggling across the U.S. border from Mexico;

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Live Oak County, Texas has determined that the ongoing border crisis constitutes that of an "invasion" of Texas and that extraordinary measures must be taken to ensure the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of county residents; and

WHEREAS §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LIVE OAK COUNTY:

That the state of disaster proclaimed for the by the County Judge on 5/10/2021 shall continue until terminated by order of the Judge or the Commissioners Court.


That this ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to local authority for emergency measures and shall become effective on the 29th day of July, 2022.


